SUMMARY OF DETAILS: On the above date and time, Police stopped a vehicle for failing to dim its high beam lights. The driver Emily FATZINGER was found to be impaired by narcotics and was arrested for DUI. The male originally gave a false name and while police were trying to identify him.
